The motion will include moving \$8,000 from the Music Leader/Office Manager account to the Professional Services account to cover the cost for the remainder of the year. 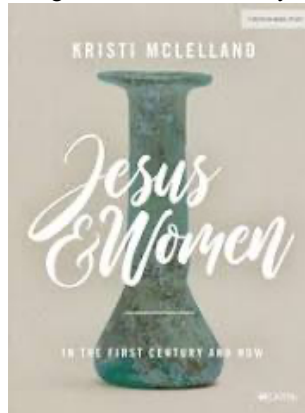
Titus 2:3-5 says that older women are to train the younger women.
