September Mission Project: Janie Chapman State Missions Offering & Soup Supper

WHY ARE WE RAISING MONEY FOR JANIE CHAPMAN STATE MISSIONS OFFERING?

That's a good question and deserves a little investigation and an answer. Here is an answer to provide information and challenge all of us to sacrifice for this cause.

The first SC State Mission offering was established on November 30, 1899 by the WMU (Women's Missionary Union) of South Carolina. The first official offering taken was September 1900 and \$235 was raised. SC women birthed the offering out of a burden for the advancement of the gospel in the state of SC. The first president of the SC WMU was Janie Weston Chapman, a pastor's wife. Due to her passionate support and involvement in the missions the state offering was named after her in 1937.

The Janie Chapman offering is a state offering, meaning that the monies given will be used in the state of SC. The uses of the offering are too many to list but include causes such as disaster relief training, college, outreach ministries, summer internships and missionaries, Christmas gifts to SC missionaries wherever they are serving, gifts to missionary kids attending college, and supporting missions to the department of juvenile justice are just to name a few. Our church wide goal is \$5,000. Please give generously from the heart.
